

**Town of Dorchester

Special Town Meeting Minutes
To Correct Procedural Defect**

Meeting called to order at 10:02 am by moderator Joshua Trought

Moderator read the warrant.

To the inhabitants of the Town of Dorchester in the County of Grafton in said state, qualified to vote in Town affairs: You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Dorchester in on Saturday, the 27th of June 2015, with action on Articles 1 and 2 to be taken commencing at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.
